Behaviours to be expected of any young person:

- Be willing to accept people, no matter of their race, gender, religion, ability or sexuality or any other difference.
- Be truthful, but also be aware of how what you say affects others
- Be willing to listen and respect other peoples opinions
- Be considerate of peoples' right to learn and participate
- Be willing to interact with others and listen to and share ideas
- Be willing to join in and contribute to the group and the creative process

Behaviours to be expected of any staff member at CLIP:

- Take the young person seriously and don't patronize them
- Make sure you listen to both sides of the story
- Take into account what the young people want to gain from the experience
- Avoid favouritism
- Try to be fair and just in the way you work with the young people
- Be friendly, positive and interactive

Advice on what to do if you see someone being bullied:

- Give support to your friends
- Talk to the victim and/or bully to help resolve the matter
- Try to contact an adult in confidence
